LOCK IT UP !

- Whenever possible, park your vehicle in your garage.
- An unlocked car is an open invitation to a thief. Lock up when you leave your car and take the keys with you.
- Lock the trunk or tailgate.
- Close all windows professional thieves have tools that unlock cars through the smallest openings.
- Be sure vents and sun-roofs are shut tight.
- When you park, remove cellular phones, lap-tops, cameras and other valuables. Take them with you or lock them in the trunk.

REDUCE YOUR RISK

- Walk with a purpose and stay alert.

OPERATION ID

- Using an electric engraver, etch your drivers license number (preceded by the letters "CA") on stereo equipment and other valuable items.
- Record your vehicle identification number (located on a small metal plate on the dashboard of newer cars) and store it in a safe place.

CARJACKING

- Keep the doors locked while in the vehicle.
- Park in well-lit, busy areas.
- Be alert of your surroundings or people approaching your vehicle.
- Stick with the traffic, avoid lightly traveled streets,
- especially after dark.
- Keep car and house keys on separate key chains.
- Keep the garage door opener in your purse or briefcase.
- When stopped in traffic, leave enough room to make an emergency getaway.
- If someone is threatening you with a weapon,
- GIVE UP THE VEHICLE IT'S NOT WORTH YOUR LIFE.
