Home Security

In 2013, one house was burglarized every day in the City of Corona. Many burglars will spend no longer than 60 seconds to try to break in. Security in your neighborhood is as effective as you make it. Make your home more secure by being aware of suspicious activities and reporting crime when it happens. By following these suggestions you can make your neighborhood a safer place in which to live.

REDUCE YOUR RISK

- Walk with a purpose and stay alert.
- Approach your home with the key in hand.
- Be wary of people asking for directions or handing out fliers.
- Be aware of your surroundings when walking to or from your home late at night.
- Never leave your door unlocked, even while taking out the trash. You may find someone waiting inside when you get back!
- Never leave valuable objects out that can be seen through
- Correct poor lighting, overgrowth of landscaping (if it looks like someone can hide in it) and broken locks.

BE AWARE!

- Make an effort to meet your neighbor's. Learn to look out for each other's interests. Know who "belongs."
- Know your neighbors vehicles. Report suspicious vehicles to the police department immediately.
- Never open your door to a stranger. Utility company employees can slip their IDs under the door. If in doubt, look up the company telephone number yourself (don't rely on a number they give you), and call to verify the information.
- Use only your first initial on your doorbell, mailbox and in the phone book. Do not identify yourself as a female living alone.
- If you return home and find a door ajar, a window open, or screen cut, DO NOT EN-TER, use your neighbors phone to call the police immediately.

VACATION PRECAUTIONS

- Call Non emergency number of Corona Police Department (951-736-2330) and let them know about your vacation plan.
- Let a neighbor *friend* know when you are going out of town so that he or she can keep an eye on any suspicious activity going on around your home. You and your neighbors can have a buddy system. He'll watch out for you when you're gone and vice versa.
 - When your home is unoccupied for a long period of time, leave a radio or television playing to give the impression that somebody is home. Utilize a timer for lamps, radio or television to give your apartment an occupied look or sound.
